

Updated Consequences Pathway - January 2019

We are constantly seeking ways to increase the amount of progress made by students. To this end, we have modified the way in which consequences are applied during lessons in order to minimise the frequency and impact of low level disruption.

This change ensures that individual students receive consequences for their own poor behaviour choices whilst warning other students that any further disruption to the learning of others will escalate further.

This change will ensure that the large majority of our students will have less lost learning time due to the poor behaviour choices of a small minority.
