# Exam preparation reflection criteria

<b>Approach</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● routinely revisit topics at increasingly spaced intervals throughout the year. I concentrate more on revisiting topics I struggle with.</li></ul>
<b>Emotional health</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● know I've done my best throughout the year, this helps me feel confident in my ability.</li></ul>
<b>Physical health</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● eat healthily and stay hydrated. I get 8-10 hours' sleep, am physically active and balance revision with relaxation.</li></ul>
<b>Revision timetable</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● practice exam techniques and complete past papers in addition to the revisiting routine I use throughout the year.</li></ul>
<b>Revision materials</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● make revision materials throughout the year after learning topics at school. Revision materials are organised into files and ticked off against subject specifications.</li></ul>
<b>Revision techniques</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● use a variety of active revision techniques which help embed knowledge in my long term memory. I collaborate with other students and ask teachers when I need help.</li></ul>



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
