Covid-19 Update

Dear Parent/Carer

We have been made aware that a one Y10 and one Y11 student have tested positive for COVID-19.

As such, the advice is that there is no need for children in other year groups to return home or self-isolate unless they become unwell with symptoms. Please be reassured that our contact tracing process has identified no connection between the positive Covid-19 cases within the school community to date.

We know that you may find this concerning but we are continuing to monitor the situation and are working closely with Public Health England and North Lincolnshire Council. This letter is to inform you of the current situation. Please be reassured that for most people, coronavirus (COVID-19) will be a mild illness.

The children who may have been in close contact with the individuals who have tested positive for coronavirus (COVID-19) have received a letter informing them that their child must stay at home for 14 days.

The Academy remains open and children in other year groups should continue to attend as normal if they remain well.
