Dear Year 11 Students and Parents

Thank you for your patience whilst waiting for confirmation of the arrangements in place for Year 11 after the completion of the Final Assessments and after May half term. We are now in a position to share and confirm the arrangements.

We are thankful to our colleagues at North Lindsey College and John Leggott College for providing an excellent package of Transition sessions from 7th June 2021 for our Year 11 students to access. This will enable our students, after a challenging year, to make the step to Post 16 Education in the best way possible.

**North Lindsey College and John Leggott College Transition Provision from 7th June.**

All of the Transition information from North Lindsey College and John Leggott College is available on our website [HERE](#). Please ensure all of the relevant information is read and any registration for sessions is completed.

Colleagues at both colleges will be keeping us updated on the engagement of our Year 11 students with the Transition package. We strongly encourage Year 11 students to access and engage fully with all relevant sessions as it will help immensely for when courses start in full in September.

We are also aware that students are being contacted by other Post 16 providers that they have applied to such as school 6th Forms or other colleges regarding transition provision in place in June and July. Again, we strongly encourage students to engage and access the provision to support their transition into Post 16 study.

The Axholme Academy will also be providing Post 16 relevant support sessions to complement the College provision either remotely or in person across a range of subjects. These are summarised below. Dates and times and whether the sessions are remote or on the Academy site will be confirmed in due course

Science	Physics, Chemistry and Biology lessons on 'Bridging the Gap between GCSE and A Level'
Maths	Remote lessons on 'Bridging the Gap between GCSE and A Level'

The significant majority of Final Assessments are completed by students at the end of *Period 3 on Wednesday 26th May*. Students will be allowed to leave the Academy site at the end of their Final Assessment on 26th May. If students need to remain on site after Period 3 on 26th May they will attend their scheduled lessons and be supervised by staff.

After 26th May Students will then move into the transition provision provided by the Colleges, other Post 16 providers or The Axholme Academy.

Students will not need to be on the Academy site unless specifically requested after 26th May.

Art, Food and Textiles students will need to attend to complete their practical assessment on Thursday 27th and Friday 28th May.

Sports Science students will need to attend as requested by Mr Beesley until all relevant work is completed.

Students have coped admirably well with all of the challenges they have been faced with during the past 15 months and should rightly be proud. Sadly, under the current restrictions the Academy still has to operate under, we cannot, at this time, have a Year 11 Leavers' Assembly. Depending on the guidance changes that potentially will come into place after 21st June we will look to have a leavers' event for Year 11 before the end of the academic year. We are still currently waiting for details regarding whether a prom will be able to take place. We will update you straight after half term regarding the Prom.

We wish our students every success in the remaining assessments.
