Y7 York Trip - Wednesday 8th July

Dear Parent/Carer,

As part of The Axholme Academy pledge and our fantastic 'Pledge Week', year 7 students have the opportunity to attend a trip to York on Wednesday 8th July. This trip will allow students to visit a traditional cultural centre and a major city which are two strands of the Academy Pledge.

Students will depart the academy at 8.30am via coach and travel to York, they will return in time for the 3pm buses. Whilst in York, your child will visit The National Railway Museum, have lunch and go on a one hour bus tour exploring York

The cost of the trip is £24.50 (non-refundable), which will cover the cost of travel to and from York and the bus tour of the city. If your child wishes to attend please make payment via ParentPay to 'York Trip 2025' by Thursday 2nd July.

Your child must bring a packed lunch for the visit. If your child is in receipt of Free School Meals and requires a grab bag lunch from the diner, this must be ordered by Friday 3rd July by completing this [FSM Grab Bag Lunch Order Form](#).

School uniforms will not be required, however, students must wear appropriate clothing for outdoors. The usual non-uniform expectations remain in place: clothing should be sensible, cropped tops and inappropriate slogans are not permitted, and garments should be of an appropriate length. A small amount of make-up and jewellery is acceptable, but hair must continue to follow our usual academy standards. All students should wear sensible footwear.

Students are also expected to have their full equipment with them.

All students are expected to have positive Ready and Able to learn attitudes whilst on the trip, and represent the academy in a positive manner.
